 - a. ARCHIVES
 - i. GSR gave updates on the recent massive RDC donation to the project's archives. Digitization is completely on hold until the Virginia Room reopens.
 - b. WALKING TOURS
 - i. COVID RESTRICTIONS: No one attended the July 12th 'Before West Station' tour although the tour had initially sold out (max. 4 participants) months in advance. When asked to reconfirm one week before the actual tour, 3 of 4 people said they had changed their plans and 1 never reconfirmed. What can we do differently next time? Options:
 - 1. Charge a minimal fee for the tour, w/ the idea that people are more likely to keep their plans if they have paid?
 - 2. Increase tour capacity? (From 5 total people to 10? Or more? Guides should discuss and seek consensus on an appropriate upper limit, understanding that there may always be attrition.)
 - 3. Ditch the reservation system altogether and just offer the tours as before COVID w/o reservations?
