# Meeting Minutes:

#### 1) ARCHIVES

- Reorganization of digital archive GSR provided updates on website redesign
- b) Graduate intern, TL, began work this week
  - Comment: We'll benefit more from TL developing a framework for ongoing event programming, rather than putting on a one-off event that we can't replicate

#### 2) ORAL HISTORIES

- a) Spring 2022 interviews are completed. Most of them will be published within the coming weeks.
- b) House of Expression oral history interviews LM will reach out to PK to see if they are still interested in doing oral history training & conducting interviews in partnership with the History Project
  - i) If we apply for SEF grant again, LM and IF would help to rewrite the grant application, to help fund House of Expression training
- c) Casa Latina IF will reach out to see if there are any LGBTQ Latinx folks interested in being interviewed

## 3) WALKING TOURS

- a) Make short videos of walking tour spots for social media promotion KS
  - i) Update: KS's phone is not good for making TikToks
  - ii) IF' wife might be able to do videography. Can do video <u>both</u> of live tours (like a highlight reel) <u>and</u> with a star (KS) talking about a specific historic site

  - ii) We need to really promote the three Pride Month walking tours (GSR will make Instagram post)

## 4) LGBT LIBRARY

- a) Book club status? Seems defunct at the moment.
  - i) We decided to let it lay fallow this summer and revisit the book club in the fall

  - ii) How to organize supplying of food, drink, set-up, clean-up, etc.?
    - (1) Send note to email thread asking each group for what they will contribute
      - (a) Food, drink, music, PA system / loud speaker, explain the literature table, 5:30pm set-up, people to clean up after dark
